

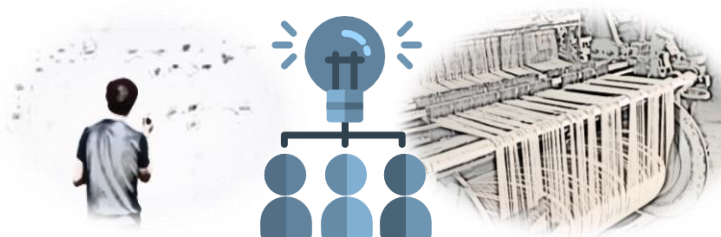

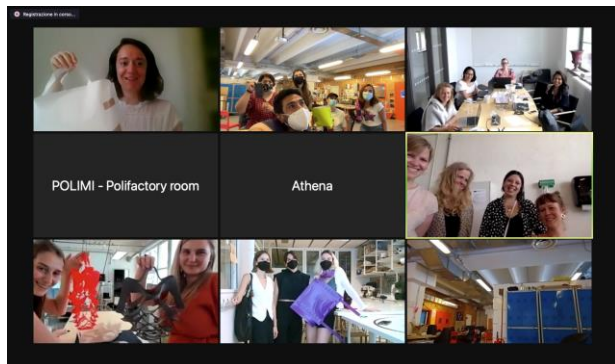

## SUMMER SCHOOL

The intensive training **summer course** previewed by the project for the summer 2021 took place in July, and it was conducted from **Milano**, with the participation of students from the Higher Education Institutions participating in the project: DSKD, UB, LCI and POLIMI.

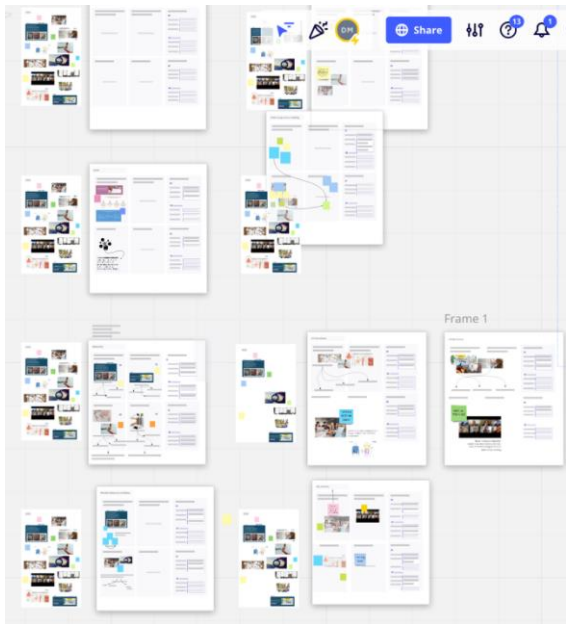
Before the summer course assistance, the **students prepared themselves** using previous **theoretical materials elaborated by the consortium**.

The summer course could not be held physically, but **students reviewed very positive the virtual adaptation** and the opportunities **and learns** that the course provided.

During the week, the students could make virtual **visits to the laboratories** of the participating universities. They could also implement **group activities related to the experience** of the visit and do some readings.

After the journeys, the students were able to prepare a **presentation of the conclusions, learnings and outstanding aspects of the day**.

The students also counted with a free-study and rest day during the week.

The consortium is now fully working on the design and development of the “Project **handbook of good practices & open challenges**: training tools and methodologies to foster creative and industrial design in advanced textiles' manufacturing sector”.

Based on the inputs collected, Materiality is producing the handbook that **will include the main results of the project**, presented as success stories, including feedback coming **from the students who participated in the Hackathons and the Summer School** and from general stakeholders.

The main aim of intellectual output 4 is to create a document containing all relevant information related to the project and its achievements as well as the open challenges to be tackled. This output will represent a sort of “lessons learned”, which will be transferred to relevant stakeholders such as companies, universities, training centers, other higher education institutions, hubs, incubators and policy-makers responsible for economic development, creativity and education. It will be an extremely important output for mainstreaming the project best practices and key success results and **to raise awareness with stakeholders of the unresolved challenges**. The handbook will be **translated into several languages** for a better dissemination to the stakeholders.

## NEXT PROJECT MEETING

For the first time after the pandemics began, **Destex consortium will meet in person next January, in Barcelona**, for its next Transnational Project Meeting and will discuss about the project advances, task and upcoming steps.
